



TO REVEAL SIN AND ITS CONSEQUENCES

We sin in thought, in word, in deed, and by failing to do things we should do. The average person sins many times daily. If we committed an average of only three sins per day, in a year we would have the guilt of more than a thousand sins upon us. Think of the sins committed in a lifetime.


